At our elevation in springtime (just like the ski areas), the weather is unpredictable; for example, we got 5-6" of snow over the weekend and lots of wind. There is still plenty of snow on the ground. That can be hard to visualize when you're looking at the flowers blooming and the trees leafing out in your yard in the lower elevations. That's the difference in the high country. Please be patient, careful and safe.
